RESALE ROYALTY SCHEME WHAT IT MEANS FOR INDIGENOUS ARTISTS

The Australian Government has appointed Copyright Agency Ltd to manage the Resale Royalty Scheme.

OVERVIEW

Artists are entitled to a 5% royalty on certain resales of their artworks.

The types of artworks covered include artists' books, batiks, carvings, ceramics, collages, digital artworks, drawings, engravings, fine art jewellery, glassware, installations, lithographs, multimedia artworks, paintings, photographs, pictures, prints, sculptures, tapestries, video artworks and weavings.

WHEN IS A ROYALTY PAYABLE?

A royalty is payable on the sale of an artwork if:

- it occurred after 8 June 2010 and is not the first change of ownership;
- the sale price is \$1,000 or more;
- the artist is alive, or their passing was fewer than 70 years ago; and
- the artist or the beneficiary of the artist's estate is Australian.

WHAT DO I NEED TO DO TO RECEIVE RESALE ROYALTIES?

If your works are resold in the future, Copyright Agency will collect a royalty for you.

By providing us with your details we can pass the payment onto you quickly. It costs you nothing to register, but you must provide certain information.

You can register online at **www.resaleroyalty.org.au** or by completing a registration form (available on the back of this information sheet).

Your art centre manager or agent can also register or provide your details to Copyright Agency for you.

Remember that royalties are not payable on the resale of artworks that were acquired before 8 June 2010.

This means that how soon you become entitled to resale royalties will depend on how quickly your work is resold after 8 June 2010.
